

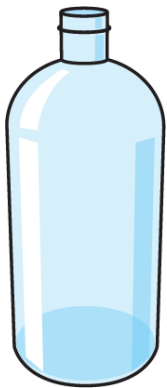
# Make a simple bird feeder

## You will need:

1. Clean plastic 500ml drinks bottle, yoghurt pot or milk carton
2. Wire or string
3. Bird seed
4. Scissors

## What to do:

1. Ask a grown up to help you cut a round hole about half way up the side of the bottle. The hole should be big enough to allow a bird access.
2. Make a few small holes in the bottom of your feeder to allow any rainwater to drain away.
3. Fill it to the hole with bird seed.
4. Hang it with wire or strong string from a tree or your washing line.

Now birds should soon start flocking to your garden to feed on your lovely seeds, But make sure your bird feeder is in good condition all the time, top it up with seeds if it's running low; if the bottle cracks or the food gets mouldy, make a new feeder. The birds in your garden will practically love your feeder once they find it, so make sure it's always in great condition for them, especially in the colder winter months.
